■ Eligibility

- Teams of two people
- Individual entries are not accepted



■ Prizes

- The champion team will receive a special grand prize.
- Contest Rules (Based on the Japan Cornhole Association Guidelines)
- ✓ Objective of the Game

Teams throw beanbags onto the board, aiming to be the first to score a total of 21 points or more.

✓ Setup & Positioning

- Team Formation: Two players per team.
- Board Placement: Two boards are placed facing each other at a distance of 8.23 meters.
- Player Positioning:
 - One member from each team stands on either side of one board (the Head Board).
 - The remaining partners stand on either side of the opposite board (the Foot Board).

✓ Game Flow

1. Throwing:

- Two players on the Head Board side alternately throw one beanbag at a time, for a total of four throws each.
 - Players must not step beyond the front edge of the board (foul line) when throwing.
- 2. Scoring for the Round:
 - After all players have thrown their four beanbags, calculate the score for that round.
- 3. Switching Sides:
 - Next, the two players on the Foot Board side throw in the same way.
- 4. Repeating:
- Continue this sequence until one team's total score reaches 21 points.

✓ Scoring

- Basic Points:
 - 1 Point (Woody): A beanbag lands on the board.
 - 3 Points (Cornhole): A beanbag goes through the hole in the board.
- Round Score (Net Scoring):
- After each round, add up the points for both teams.
- The team with the higher total earns the difference between the two scores as their round score.

• Example: Team A scores 12 points and Team B scores 8 points. The difference is 4 points, so 4 points are added to Team A's total score.
